Obstacles

Common barriers that might prevent someone from working:

1. Childcare

Child care expenses can pose a major obstacle to self-sufficiency. For example, a single mother making minimum wage can pay over 45% of her take home income to child care expenses. Below are the average monthly costs of quality child care in Wake County for Infants through 5 years of age in 2006.

- Infants — \$906.42/mo.
- 1 yr. olds — \$856.33/mo.
- 2 yr. olds — \$763.66/mo.
- 3 yr. olds — \$703.90/mo.
- 4 yr. olds — \$691.21/mo.
- 5 yr. olds — \$676.24/mo.

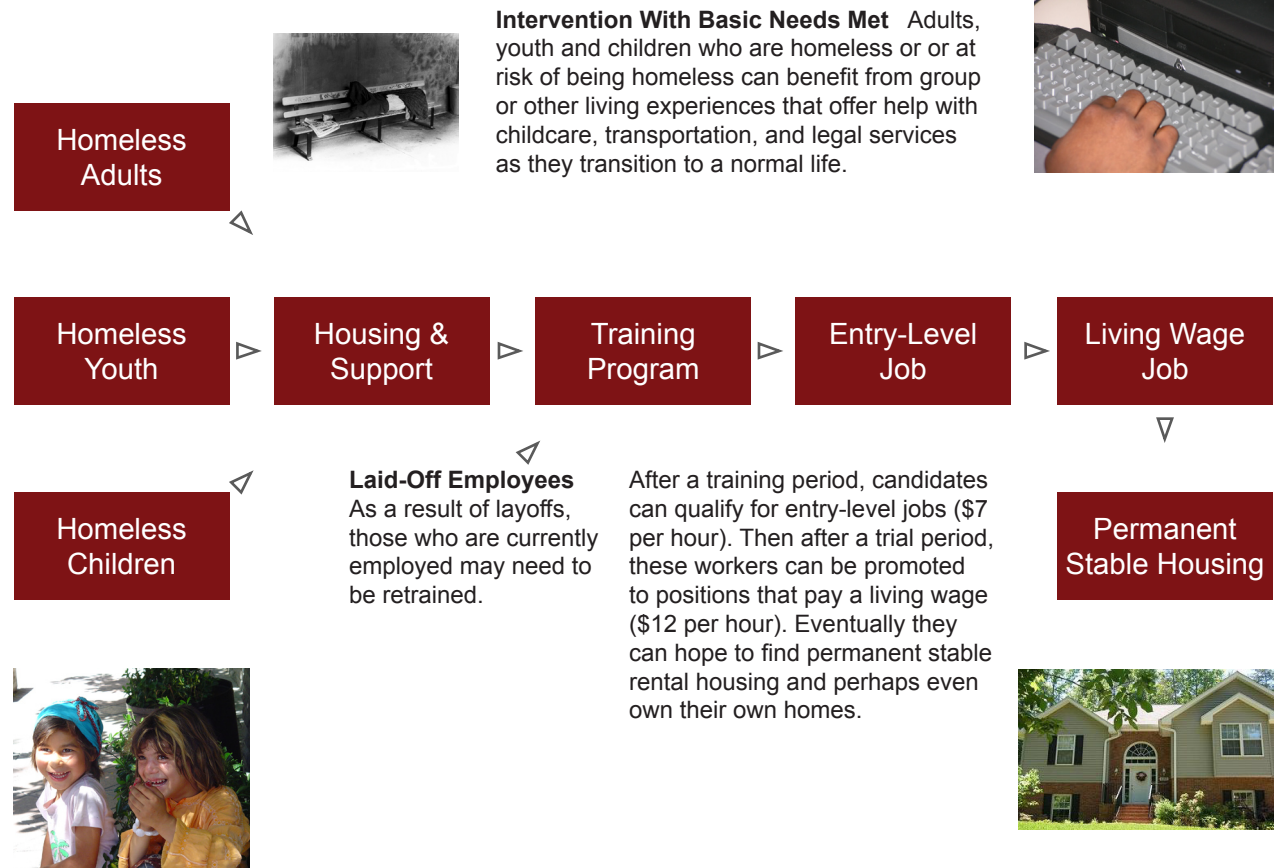
2. Transportation
